The John A. Logan College catalog was reviewed for the Construction Management Technology, Associate in Applied Science degree. This degree requires a total of 70-74 semester hours of coursework. The following is my evaluation of the applicable Surveyor-In-Training education requirement items.

Land Surveying: 24 semester hour requirement. No acceptable Land Surveying courses are in this program, thus 24 semester hours of Land Surveying needed.

Pure Science: 8 semester hour requirement.

PHY 121: Technical Physics (3sh)

A total of 3 semester hours of Pure Science, thus 5 semester hours of Pure Science needed.

Mathematics: 15 semester hour requirement. No acceptable Mathematics courses are in this program, thus 15 semester hours of Mathematics needed.

Additional Science: 20 semester hour requirement.

CMG 209: Environmental Systems (3sh)

PHY 225: Structural Mechanics II (3sh)

A total of 9 semester hours, thus 11 semester hours of Additional Science needed.
